



# ADULTS WITH ATTENTION DEFICIT / HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER

*A new clinical treatment study may interest you.*

Participants are needed for a clinical study of **controlled-release methylphenidate** to treat Attention Deficit / Hyperactivity Disorder (ADD or ADHD) in adults, aged 18 to 60.

The study involves regular visits to our clinic in Vancouver, over a period of three months. Assessments, physical exam, and study medication are provided at no cost. If your ADHD improves after treatment with controlled-release methylphenidate, an additional six months of follow-up treatment will be provided.

This study is designed to determine how well the medication helps people to manage their ADHD symptoms. For one-half of the time in the study (approximately 6 weeks), participants will receive controlled-release methylphenidate. For the other-half of the study, participants will receive placebo (inactive medication). The order in which this occurs is determined by chance.
