Warden

The ward is responsible for supervising and maintaining all council property, except that which belong to the financial secretary.

He sets up the council chambers for meetings and degrees and appoints and supervised guards for ceremonial exemplifications. The warden should also oversee the inside and outside guards and make sure they are fulfilling the duties assigned to them.

Inside/ Outside Guards

The guards attend the doors of the council chamber, checking on current membership cards before allowing entrance.
