

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Historica Fairs Program believes that every student has the potential to become a self-disciplined, positive, contributing member of society. The Program also believes that students have the right to expect a safe, nurturing, educational environment. This code of conduct is intended to encourage acceptable student behaviour throughout the Vancouver Regional Historica Fair and to provide an atmosphere where all individuals feel a sense of respect, safety and belonging.

Student Participants are expected to:

- Attend both days of the Vancouver Regional Historica Fair.
- Conduct themselves in an acceptable manner at all times.
- Respect and accept the authority of student supervisors, volunteers and Historica Fair staff.
- Set high standards for personal achievement in the Regional Fair activities.
- Be punctual and enthusiastic in attending all scheduled activities.
- Dress in an appropriate manner and to wear the student name tag at all times.
- Conduct themselves in a polite, respectful and co-operative manner at all times.
- Be considerate of the thoughts, feelings, values and heritage of others.
- Be free of illegal drugs, alcohol, and all tobacco products during the Fair.
- Leave valuables at home or in the care of a responsible adult.

To ensure correct student behaviour, the Historica Fairs Program will create an environment, which will encourage students to exercise self-discipline by:

- Developing programs that promote appropriate behaviour.
- Using methods that enhance self-esteem and self-discipline.
- Providing opportunities for students to practice co-operative behaviour.
- Using procedures which model fairness, equity and respect for all
