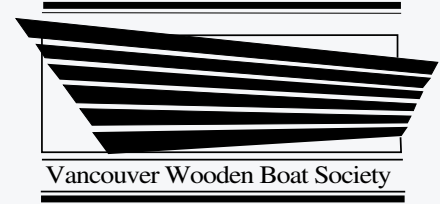

RULES

- 1) Boats can be of any size or age, but must be completely constructed of wood. Cold molded vessels are eligible.
- 2) Boats entered in the show must be in reasonable shape.
- 3) Owners wishing to participate must be prepared to open their boats for inspection by Society officials prior to the show.
- 4) No For Sale signs or chartering will be allowed at the show.
- 5) **Indicate if electricity will be required – user fee is \$15**
- 6) The Society reserves the right to refuse admission to any vessel it considers ineligible.
- 7) Festival entry fee is:
\$36 for boats under 19'
\$68 for boats 20' to 35'
\$89 for boats 36' to 50'
\$120 for boats 51' to 75'
\$142 for boats over 75'
