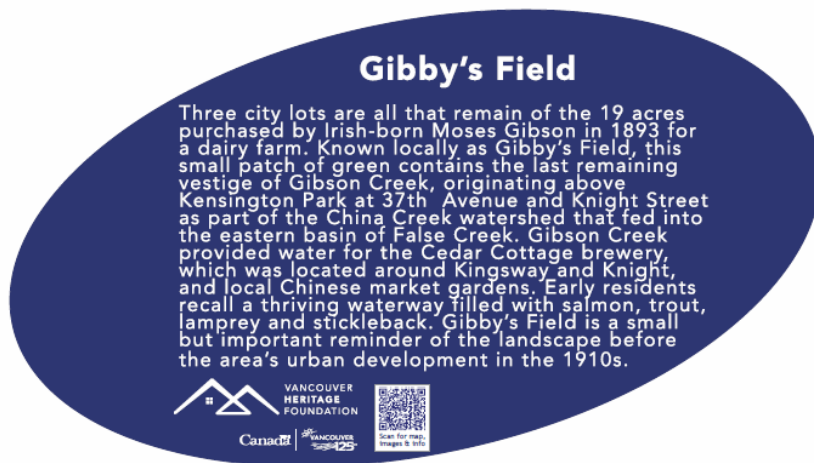


Friday 3 May 2013:

Three Gibby's Field Related Events

Two creeks, **Gibson Creek** and **Davey Creek**, met at Gibby's Field, which took its name from **Moses Gibson** (1850–1937), a local landowner and farmer. Gibby's Field is at 1454/1458/1462 East 18th Avenue, in the dip between Knight and Dumfries.

4pm: Walking tour of Gibson Creek and Davey Creek (60–75 minutes), starting and ending at Tye.

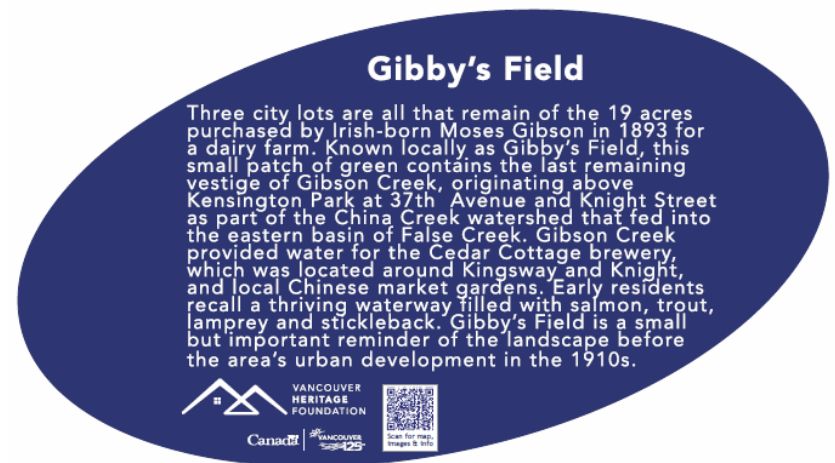
