
Friday 3 May 2013: Three Gibby's Field Related Events

Two creeks, **Gibson Creek** and **Davey Creek**, met at Gibby's Field, which took its name from **Moses Gibson** (1850–1937), a local landowner and farmer. Gibby's Field is at 1454/1458/1462 East 18th Avenue, in the dip between Knight and Dumfries.

Gibby's Field was chosen as one of 125 Vancouver sites to receive a historical plaque as part of the Vancouver Heritage Foundation's "Places That Matter" project.



Three events take place **Friday 3 May** 2013 to mark installation of the plaque. All welcome.

2pm: **Plaque dedication** at Gibby's Field.

3pm: **Reception** at Tyee Elementary School, 3525 Dumfries Street, at same time as Tyee's annual **plant sale** (3pm–8pm).

4pm: **Walking tour** of Gibson Creek and Davey Creek (60–75 minutes), starting and ending at Tyee.
