Once again we received a flood of registration applications immediately after the notice was issued on April 28, 2005. By noon on April 29 all 50 available seats were filled. There are 64 names on the waiting list!

The deadline for cancellations is midnight Wednesday May 18, 2005. If you do not cancel by this time, you will be responsible for the registration fee.

In addition to the two seminars originally planned for the Fall of 2005, the Society is now planning to repeat two PD Seminars from the 2005 program. The intent is to provide additional education opportunities for PMPs in the community with a minimum of organizational effort for the presenters and the Project Management team. The dates for the repeat seminars are June 16, 2005 (tentative) and October 25, 2005.

The February, April, and May 2005 seminars were sold out within two days of the notice. In fact, they were oversubscribed by more than 100%!
