This is an upgraded version of the Society website which has been in place since 2001. The upgraded site was launched on November 17, 2009, and is the product of volunteer work by Society members. The Upgrade Project was initiated at the Annual Meeting in November, 2006.

Key features of the upgraded site include:

- o an archive of proceedings from the 45 professional development seminars that have been held since the inception of the Society in 2000
- o a full set of documents for the management of a professional development seminar. The documents for download include the Seminar Management Manual and templates for the binder, registration messages, and completion reports among others

The site is largely complete. The major exception is the archive of seminar proceedings. Illustrative archival descriptions are available for three of the 45 Professional Development seminars held to date. The archival descriptions include abstracts, presenter and workshop leader biographies, and presentation documents and slides for download. We have the content for the remaining descriptions. Only the preparation of the HTML pages and the securing of author permissions to publish remain to be done. The other outstanding deliverables from the project are an operating manual and operations training.
