

STANDARD 10-CODE

10-4	ACKNOWLEDGEMENT	Acknowledges receipt of a message and indicates it will be dealt with as required and/or requested.
10-6	BUSY	Self-Explanatory.
10-7	OUT OF SERVICE	Self-Explanatory. The unit should indicate location and reason for radio log. i.e. "Unit 1, 10-7 Steveston Station, picking up new radio." If the unit is 10-7 for a very long time, such as a relief break, the unit will indicate location and duration of 10-7, i.e. "Unit 1, 10-7, No. 1 Road and Steveston Hwy, 5 minutes.
10-8	IN SERVICE	Self-Explanatory. The unit will 10-8 when coming on shift or returning to service from a call or other duty.
10-9	REPEAT	Self-Explanatory.
10-10	NEGATIVE	Self-Explanatory.
10-11	REMAIN IN SERVICE	Remain in service until advised.
10-14	PREPARE TO COPY	Self-Explanatory.
10-20	LOCATION	Self-Explanatory.
10-21	TELEPHONE	Unit to telephone (cell phone). i.e. "Unit 1, 10-21 Base."
10-23	ARRIVED AT SCENE	Self-Explanatory.
10-24	RETURN TO...	Self-Explanatory. i.e. "Unit 1, 10-24 Base."
10-25	MAKE A MEET	Self-Explanatory. i.e. "Unit 1, 10-25 Blundell and Garden City."
10-33	EMERGENCY	All Stations or Units shall maintain radio silence until the emergency transmission is made. i.e. "Unit 1, 10-33." Base: "All units 10-6, go ahead Unit 1." Unit 1: "Occupied stolen, Francis and No.3 Rd."
10-61	COFFEE BREAK	Self-Explanatory.
10-62	LUNCH BREAK	Self-Explanatory.
10-67	UNAUTHORIZED LISTENER PRESENT	Self-Explanatory.

10-68	IMPAIRED DRIVER	Self-Explanatory.
10-71	ADVISE SITUATION/ STATUS	Self-Explanatory. i.e. Base: "Unit 1, 10-71." Unit 1: "Suspect vehicle now eastbound Francis at St.Albans."
10-72	ALARM OR SERIOUS CRIME	Self-Explanatory.
10-75	CHANGE FREQUENCY/ CHANNEL	Self-Explanatory.
10-86	POLICE REQUIRED	Self-Explanatory.
